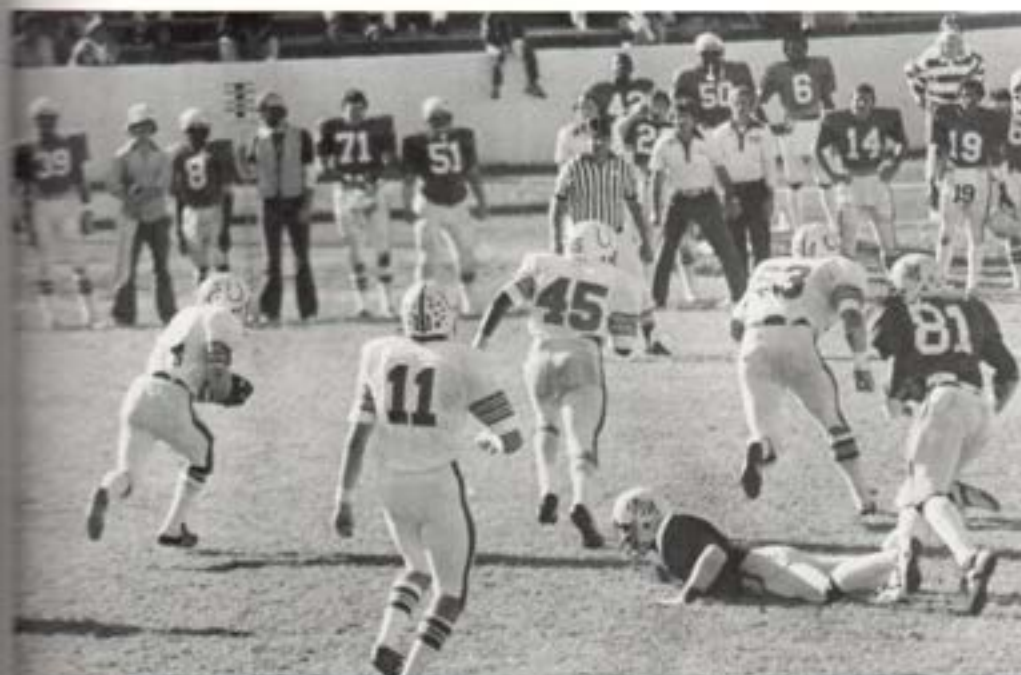

GOOD SEASON FOR RIDERETTES

The Riderette Basketball Team came charging back from an early season next-to-last place to fourth place in the Arkansas Women's Intercollegiate Sports Association (AWISA) conference. They placed third in the AWISA Play-offs holding off ASU in Jonesboro on February 21-24. In the first round of the play-offs, the Riderettes defeated Ouachita Baptist University 62-60 in a tough physical game. The following night, a softened-up Riderette squad lost to the Univ. of Arkansas at Monticello 73-62, but rebounded back the third night to stun the number three seed team, Univ. of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, 64-54 to take Third Place in the AWISA Play-offs. The victory gave the Riderettes the right to represent Arkansas in the Southwest Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for women (SWALAW) Championship. This small college regional championship is composed of top teams from Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.

For the second successive year, the Riderettes will graduate three starting seniors. Sandra Haley, senior from Melbourne, did an outstanding job for the Riderettes the entire season. Compared to all other players in AWISA, Sandra was seventh in individual scoring with 14 Points per game; third in individual field goal shooting with 62 percent. Sandra was also named to the All-AWISA Second Team. Lila Smith, from Stephens, also did a fine job this season, averaging 11 points and 5 assists per game. Judy Mewbourn, from Canton, Texas, was quarterback for the Riderettes averaging 4 assists per game and spearheading the SAU defensive attack.

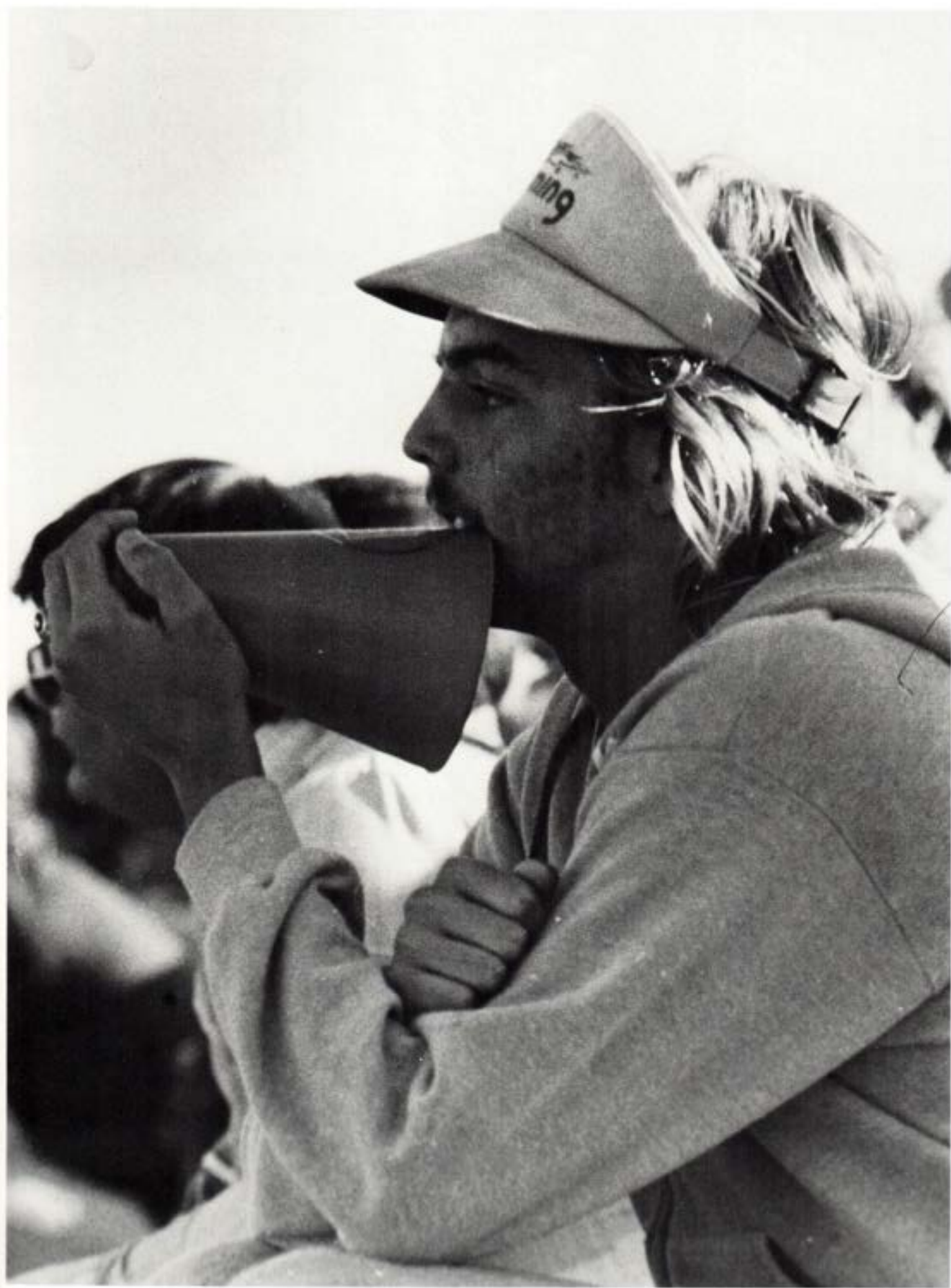

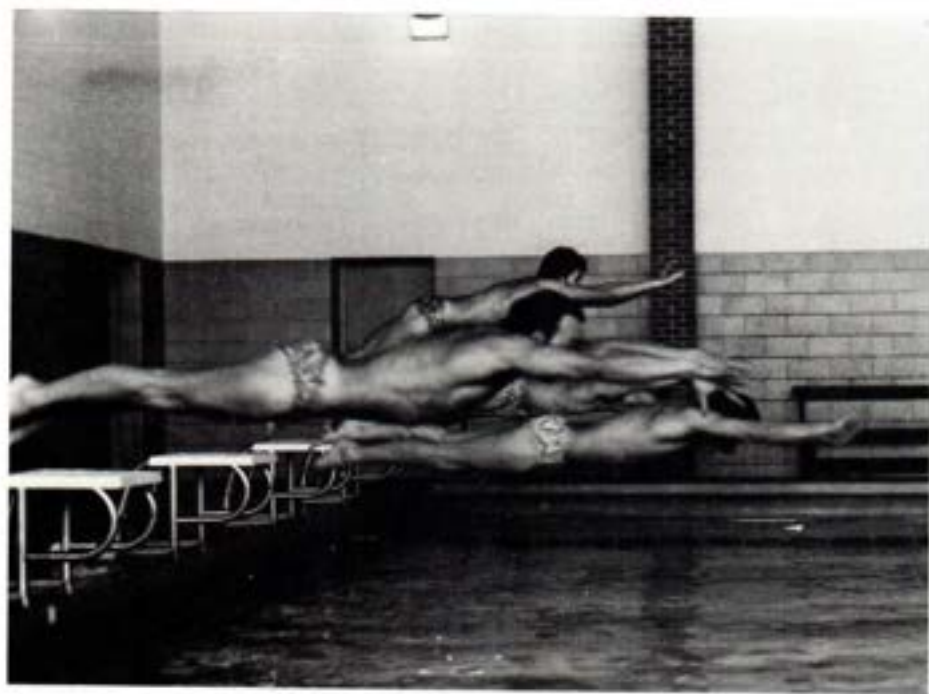

As students and faculty trudged home after the bracing and invigorating day there was contentment on their faces.



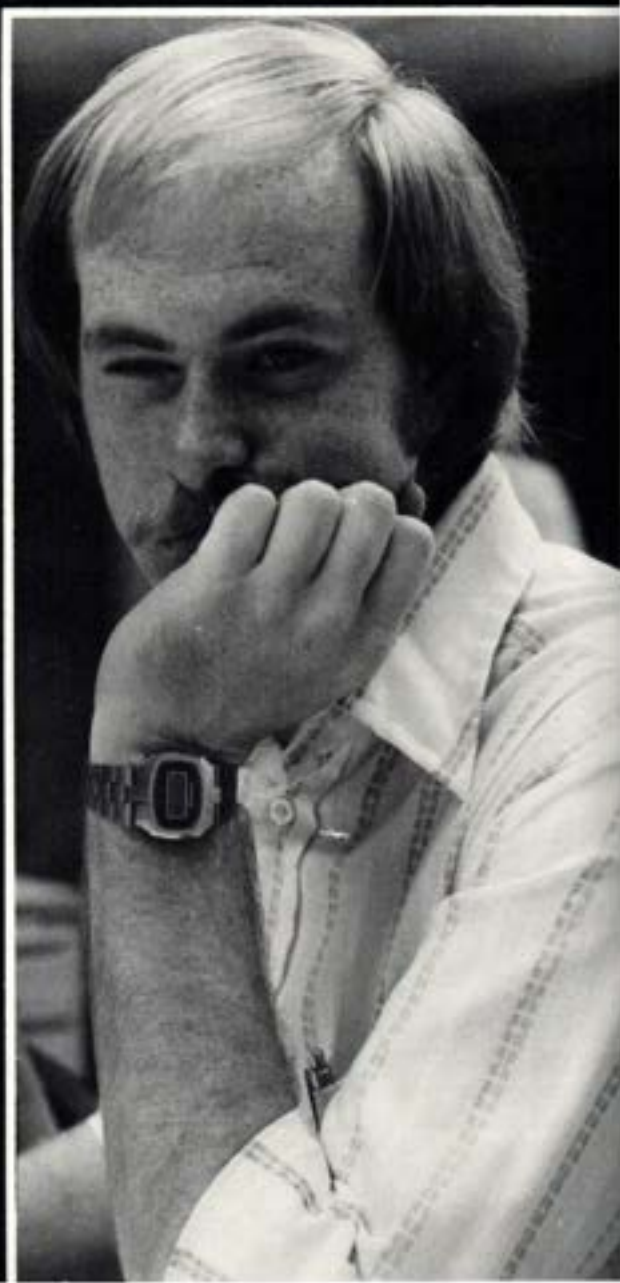




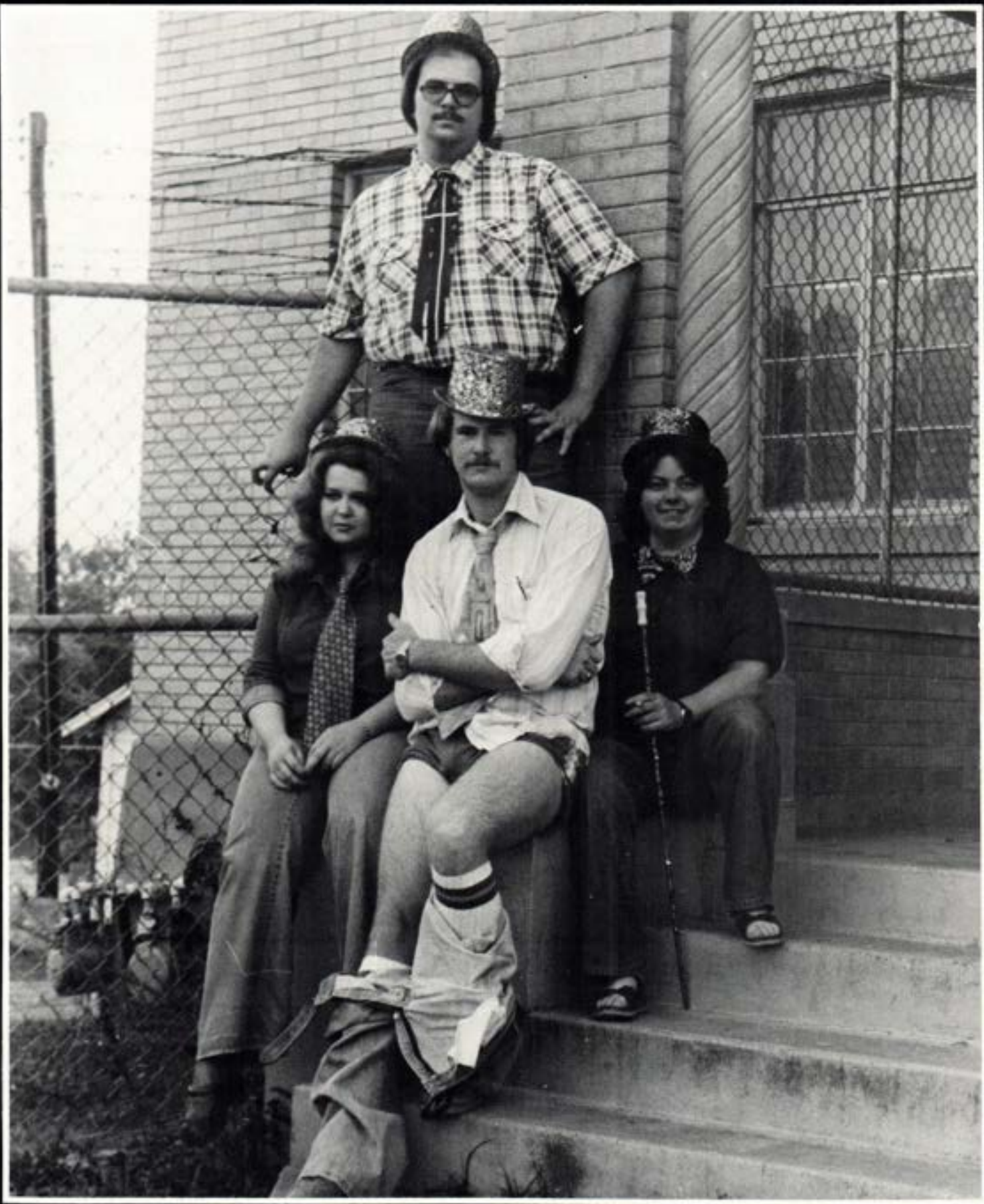
